

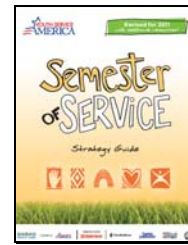

### Semester of Service Strategy Guide & Classroom Planning Calendar

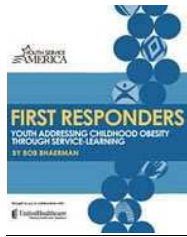
