

Here is some other information to make your visit to Croatia more enjoyable:

<p>Currency—The official currency of Croatia is the kuna (100 kunas is about \$18 or 14 euros). In some shops, euros are accepted. Taxis take kunas and some take euros.</p>			
<p>Water—Tap water is good to drink and bottled water is always available.</p>			
<p>Low Temperature 3°C 38°F</p>	<p>High Temperature 12°C 54°F</p>	<p>Weather—In March, the weather at the sea is changeable. You should plan for cool weather at night and possible rain. Average temperatures are 8 C or 46 F during the day and 3 C or 38 F at night.</p>

		<p>Hotel/City Transport--CEESA will transport the participants to the City and back on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon. Cabs can be arranged and cost about kn 200 / 28 euros each way.</p>
