SCHOOL GOVERNANCE IN AN INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENT Saturday, November 23, 2013 9:00 AM- 4:00 PM American School of Warsaw

This all-day workshop, focused on school governance, team building, and current educational trends, is designed for School Board Chairs, School Directors, and Embassy/Consulate Liaison Officers working as a team.

- >Focus will be on high performing Boards of Directors.

SESSION TOPICS:

Based on participant input prior to and at the beginning of the workshop, time will be allocated appropriately around the following questions:

- How does the governing team view and assess the school's current strengths and weaknesses?
- How can the embassy/consulate and the school best work together to the benefit of each organization?
- What role does our school's vision and mission play in guiding governance decisions?
- What are the most current educational trends in both American and international education?
- How well is our school positioned to educate students to live and work in a global environment in the 21st century?
- What are the most important changes we need to make to improve our school?
- How can we work more effectively as a team around difficult change issues?
- How can the Board work more effectively together?
- How can the Board work more effectively with the Head?
- How can our meetings be more effective?
- How can we improve the criteria, time line, and/or process for evaluating the Director/Head?
- What are our school's 3-5 most important goals for next year?

The workshop will be held from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM at the American School of Warsaw, on Saturday, November 23, 2013. The American School of Warsaw is co-hosting this workshop with CEESA.
